

### MAJOR CHANGES: FINANCING PLAN



- Modification to data fields to better feed into RCC
- New submissions areas for:
  - Resident Comments from meeting(s) held post-CHAP
  - Title Report
- "Fair Housing, Civil Rights, and Relocation Checklist"
  - Currently encompasses "FHEO Accessibility and Relocation Checklist"
  - Future PRA will consolidate fair housing, civil rights, and relocation items into single form

- "Form" is a paper version of the online submissions that will continue to occur on the RAD Resource Desk
- Training will be provided when PRA process is completed



#### MAJOR CHANGES: RAD CONVERSION COMMITMENT



- Reformatted so that all data inputs appears on first two pages
- New information listed to better capture the key features of the transaction
- Simplifies exhibits
  - Forms of Use Agreement and HAP contract and Key Business
     Terms have been removed
  - Closing Checklist replaces Closing Requirements Exhibit
  - Critical and Post-closing Repairs placed in one exhibit
- Draft RCC will be available to PHAs prior to issuance



### MAJOR CHANGES: RAD USE AGREEMENT



- Provides clarity around units and property covered under the Use Agreement
- Use Agreement remains in effect until HUD executes a release
- Provides consent for certain transfers, conveyances, and encumbrances
- Incorporates lender rider
- RCC no longer a required exhibit



## **MAJOR CHANGES: HAP CONTRACTS**



- Clarifies Initial Year Funding provisions
- Provides standard Davis-Bacon "Addendum to the HAP Contract – Labor Standards"
- Strengthens and clarifies mandatory contract renewal provision and incorporation of resident procedural rights
- Provides HUD consent for certain common LIHTC assignments
- Incorporates Lender and LIHTC rider provisions
